City Launches New Interactive Maps

The City of Campbell River has added a brand new interactive mapping experience to its website and Community Portal.

The City Map experience features local mapping, with zoning, parkland, aerial photos and much more, including the Official Community Plan map.

The City began developing and using computer-based mapping in 2001 and recently updated our systems for online delivery of all our geospatial data.

The Public City Map features 23 different layers including:

- Property Information, with House Numbering and Parcel Plans
- Zoning and Zoning By-Law Descriptions
- Landmarks
- Utilities
- Parks and Trails
- Garbage Pickup
- Transportation Routes
- Aerial photos and Hillshade Imagery

The Official Community Plan Map includes 10 themes, augmented by base layers and aerial photographs:

- Land Use
- Plan Areas
- Downtown Areas
- Density
- Agricultural Land Reserves (ALR)
- Recreational Greenways
- Floodplain Risk
- Environmentally-Sensitive Areas (ESA)
- Transportation
- Pedestrian Routes
