Robron Park Site Design Final Open House

The City of Campbell River is hosting its third and final Open House to review the Robron Park site design options on Thursday, October 8 from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. at the Sportsplex. This is the last chance for public input into the design of Robron Park.

After two public open houses, a preliminary findings review to Council and open comments from the public, Options 7A, 7B and 8 are the final options being considered for recommendation to Council. All options include the addition of an artificial turf sportsfield, a lacrosse box and expanded parking at Merecroft.

The differences between the options include:

- removal of the tennis courts and completing an upgrade to the courts at Centennial Park in Option 7A
- relocation of the tennis courts to the upper ball diamond in option 7B
- relocation of the tennis courts to the east to accommodate the lacrosse box between the artificial turf and the tennis courts in Option 8

Options 7A, 7B and 8 can be viewed on the City's website as of Friday, October 2. A public response form is included and all comments must be received by HBLANARC, the landscape architect conducting the design process, no later than Friday, October 9, 2009.
