City Disappointed, Considering Options on Court's TimberWest Taxation Decision

The BC Supreme Court has ordered that 2009 taxes levied by the City of Campbell River on managed forest lands owned by TimberWest be set aside.

"We are disappointed in the Court's decision, and we are still evaluating the impact of this order on the City," says Mayor Charlie Cornfield.

The City's lawyer and staff are currently reviewing Judge Gerow's December 31 decision that the City reconsider its tax rates bylaw as applied to Class 7 property and will report to Council.

"Once we have the options presented, this will be discussed by Council," says the Mayor.
