Managed by the Campbell River Visitor Centre, the Community Events Calendar offers a onestop location to view (and post!) all community group meetings, sports and cultural events, community celebrations and fun activities and festivals for all ages and interests.

The Community Events Calendar offers a quick look at the day, week, month or year. At <a href="https://www.campbellriverbc.ca">www.campbellriverbc.ca</a>, click on "Events" and the calendar pops into view. Select the day, week or month of interest and click "expand all" to see every listing. Click on the listing for more details.

Events features on the Community Events Calendar must be held within the Strathcona Regional District, open to the general public and be of community interest.

The Community Events Calendar pulls together information from a number of other sources, including: newspapers, the Campbell River Recreation Guide, the Volunteer Centre, the Campbell River Multicultural and Immigrant Services Association, the What's On Digest, 50+ Active Living Bulletins, Chamber news, Art Gallery updates and more.

"The Recreation and Culture Department uses this very useful tool as another way to promote events and activities," says Ross Milnthorp, the City's general manager of parks, recreation and culture. "We hope that all community groups and associations will use the Community Events Calendar to promote their activities and that the community will regularly refer to this source to find comprehensive community event information."
