CUPE Local 401 and City of Campbell River reach tentative collective agreement

Canadian Union of Public Employees (CUPE) Local 401 and the City of Campbell River have reached a tentative deal on the renewal of the collective agreement.

This tentative agreement requires formal approval by CUPE Local 401 members and Campbell River City Council.

Further details will be released should the terms of the agreement be ratified by both parties.

Consideration of the tentative deal is expected to take place over the next couple of weeks.

"We appreciate the hard work and dedication of both CUPE and City staff in negotiating a tentative deal," says Laura Ciarniello, the City's General Manager of Corporate Services. "We're hoping the terms will be approved and that ratification of the deal will take place in November."
