Expect delays due to road work at two intersections early next week

The City of Campbell River will conduct road repair at two intersections next week.

Work at the corner of St Ann's and Alder Street will include milling and repaving of this intersection over two days, Monday, July 18 and Tuesday, July 19 between 8 a.m. and 2 p.m. each day.

Milling and repaving the intersection at Petersen and Evergreen will also take place July 18 and 19, between noon and 6 p.m.

During this period, drivers should expect delays as traffic will alternate through a single lane at both locations.

Alternative routes are recommended, either along Dogwood Street or Hwy. 19A, during the road repair times.

Road repair and repaving continues the City's timely maintenance of infrastructure around the community. The work is funded as part of the yearly roads department operations.

The City apologizes in advance for any inconvenience caused during the two days of road repair.
