## Modifications to log peeling plant successfully reduce noise

Independent consultants have confirmed that noise coming from the log peeling operation on Duncan Bay Road has been reduced.

A letter from BKL Sound Consultants confirmed to City Council that the plant owners have "fully implemented the noise abatement methods approved by the City."

The modifications to the plant and certification that modifications had successfully reduced the sound of the operation were required by Campbell River's Public Nuisance Bylaw.

"The modifications to the plant have been very successful in reducing the noise from the debarker, to the point where it no longer contravenes the City's noise regulations," said City Clerk Peter Wipper.

A copy of the letter, along with a staff report was distributed with Council's July 24 meeting agenda.
