Boat Ramp open house Mar. 20 invites public input

The City of Campbell River invites members of the public to attend an open house Wednesday, Mar. 20 from 7 to 9 p.m. at the Sportsplex, Room 2.

"Campbell River residents have been looking forward to ramp upgrades at Big Rock boat ramp, and two conceptual designs for the project will be presented at the open house," says Lynn Wark, the City's parks project supervisor.

Upgrade possibilities for the Big Rock boat ramp include replacement of the ramp, improved parking, public washroom, lighting and fish-cleaning station. Also under consideration is integration of McAllum Park into the ramp area improvements and the potential for overflow parking at 921 Island Highway.
