Project Overview

Work under this project consisted of the replacement of approximately 565 metres of watermain on Dogwood Street between 4th and 7th Avenue. The existing watermain was undersized and was replaced with a main required to address system deficiencies.



RFP 773 was approved by Council May 13, 2014 and the contract was awarded to the design-build team of Upland Excavating Ltd. and McElhanney Consulting Services Ltd. Construction was completed in August 2014.



Funding for the Project

The project was funded through Water Capital with the final total cost of design and construction works associated with the Dogwood Watermain Replacement Project of \$510,680 against the approved budget of \$530,215.
