Work under this project included the extension of the City's municipal broadband network along 11th Avenue from Cedar Street to Dogwood Street, and Dogwood Street from 11th to 12th Avenue.

### **Funding for the Project**

The project was approved in the 2020 Capital Plan. The cost for the civil work was \$80,000 and funded by the Gaming Reserve.
