

CENTENNIAL PARK UPGRADE PROJECT Fall/Winter 2013

On Time and On Budget!

Project Overview

In the 1920's the Ministry of Forests established a Ranger Station on the property, and in 1955 the Rotary Club and Village Planning Commission recognized a need for a park within the City, and Centennial Park was established.

The Centennial Park Upgrade Project involved extensive outreach to the community to ensure the project aligned with community input. This included upgrading the existing multisport court and replacing the existing play equipment with a natural playscape in this 1.63 hectare park; which is intended to encourage interactive play with natural elements. The result is a larger improved play area set amongst the second growth fir trees and multisport courts; which included the addition of basketball hoops and ball hockey nets.

Design was awarded to Gemella Design Inc., and construction was awarded to Milestone Equipment Contracting Inc., both of Nanaimo, BC.



Funding for the Project

The project was jointly funded by a \$225,300 grant from the Western Economic Diversification Community Infrastructure Fund, with the balance of the \$461,000 project budget being funded by the City's Parks Parcel Tax. The project has completed on time and on budget.
