Project Update: Here's What You Need to Know

This letter is to update the residents impacted by the ongoing utility renewal project that is nearing completion.

What have we been up to?

The General Contractor (ECG) has completed the installation of the new storm and sanitary sewer mains and services along 6th Avenue. Watermain installation on 6th Ave. and on Thulin St. between 5th Ave. and 6th Ave. are also close to completion.

The section of watermain on Thulin Street within the archaeological site is also now installed and will be operational once water services are completed. A Site Alteration Permit (SAP) was issued by the province in mid-August and has allowed the project to proceed with archaeological oversight.

The contractor is currently completing the surface restoration related works. This includes setting manhole lids, restoring concrete curbs, sidewalks and asphalt paving.

What's next?

The watermain along Thulin will be tested and activated once the water services are completed. Some temporary water service disruptions are to be expected. The contractor will notify you in advance of any disruptions.

Subject to the weather, the contractor will restore the boulevards, landscaped areas, and driveways. Some of these restoration areas may unfortunately be delayed due to the change in weather. This means the City and the Contractor will monitor performance of some of these seasonal deficiencies over the winter months and postpone or redo items that require attention in the spring of 2024.
