We're Getting Ready—Here's What You Need to Know

Watermain upgrades on Cedar Street will be starting soon in your area.



The Cedar Street Watermain Replacement Project is about to begin. This project involves the renewal of approximately 100 lineal metres of watermain on Cedar Street between 9th Avenue and 942 Cedar Street. The work includes the installation of a new watermain, a new fire hydrant, new service connections and associated valving. Some of the existing curbs will be replaced and the entire roadway will be re-paved.

Getting Ready for Construction

Work is expected to commence in the next week and be completed by mid-August. The work is generally limited to the road right of way and will see the new watermain installed under the roadway. The new water services will be connected to the existing services at or near the property line. The boulevards and landscaping will be restored.

Road Closures

This project will require single lane closure around the active work area with alternating traffic passing the work zone. The contractor will be required to maintain appropriate traffic control throughout the course of construction. For everyone's safety, all drivers and pedestrians should obey the traffic control personnel as they direct you through the active work zone.



The contractor is proposing to work from 7:30 AM to 5:30 PM. During these hours, street parking on Cedar Street will not be available. Your cooperation in following these restrictions would be appreciated. Overnight parking will be allowed.

All effected properties will be given 72 hours advance notice of disruptions to water. It is anticipated there will be a single day-long shutdown as the new watermain and services are connected.
