We're Getting Ready—Here's What You Need to Know

Utility upgrades will be starting soon in your area.



The Fir Street Utility Upgrade Project is about to begin. The project involves the replacement of approximately 380 lineal meters of watermain on Fir Street from 9th Avenue northward to the 1100Blk Laneway, accompanied by approximately 175 lineal meters of storm drain improvements from 10th Avenue to the 1100 Blk Laneway. In general terms the work includes the installation of new services, hydrants, manholes, catch basins, headwalls and miscellaneous appurtenances followed by reinstatement of the affected asphalt road surface and flat works.

Getting Ready for Construction

Work is expected to commence in early April and be completed by July 2019. The work is generally limited to the road right of way and will see the new watermain installed under the roadway. The new water services will be connected to the existing services at or near the property line. The boulevards and landscaping will be restored.

Road Closures

This project will require single lane closure around the active work area with alternating traffic passing the work zone. The contractor will be required to maintain appropriate traffic control throughout the course of construction. For everyone's safety, all drivers and pedestrians should obey the traffic control personnel and signage.

Construction Impacts

The contractor will be working between the hours of 7:00 AM to 5:30 PM. During these hours, street parking on Fir Street will not be available. Temporary driveway closures will be experienced as the work progresses. Your cooperation in following these restrictions would be appreciated. Overnight parking will be allowed.

All effected properties will be given 72 hours advance notice of disruptions to water. It is anticipated there will be a single day-long shutdown as the new watermain and services are connected.
