TIME TO APPLY FOR 2021 PERMISSIVE TAX EXEMPTIONS!

PTE applications, along with all supporting documentation, will be accepted until **4:30 p.m. Friday, June 26, 2020** for 2021 exemptions.

Permissive property tax exemptions are available for property that is either owned or held by a church, charitable, philanthropic or non-profit organization that meets the requirements prescribed by Section 224 of the Community Charter and City Council's Finance Policy.
