WINTER ROAD MAINTENANCE

What we do:

- Watch the weather and form a plan.
- Apply brine before the snow falls.
- Salt/sand the roads once the snow starts.
- Plows head out before priority roads accumulate 2 inches of snow.
- Monitor road conditions and maintain minimal snow depths based on City policy.
- Adapt our plan based on local conditions and the weather forecast.



City crews work 24/7 to keep priority roads clear of snow. During regular work hours, once priority roads are clear and as resources allow, the City will plow local roads, City facilities, sidewalks and bus stops.

TEMPORARY WATER PRESSURE DECREASE

On **Wednesday, November 23**, City water crews will repair a primary water main. During the repair, areas of the City – particularly those in higher elevations – may notice a drop in water pressure. **There is no need to report a drop in water pressure during this time.**



To help lessen the strain on the water system, conserve water.

Only run the dishwasher or washing machine when full, take shorter showers and don't run the water continuously when brushing your teeth or washing your hands.
