**Where: Enterprise Centre, City Hall, 301 St. Ann's Rd**

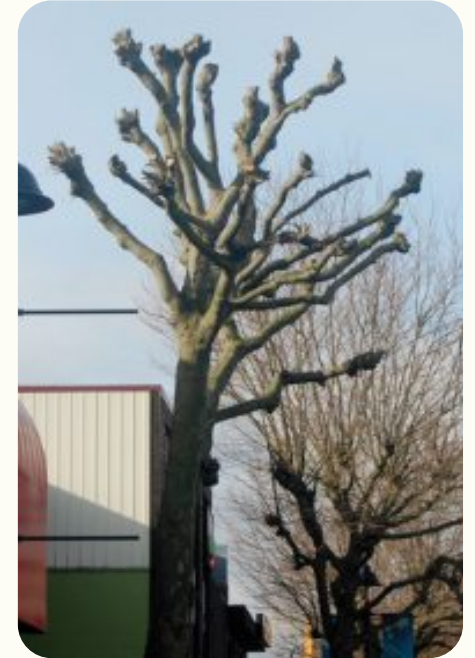
## Highlights of the changes include:

- Streamlining the permit application, inspection and payment processes,
- Language clarity for better understanding within the building community and City practices,
- Requirements for fire suppression systems that align with the building code,
- Changes to registered professional involvement for architects and engineers,
- Supports added for projects that involve the BC Energy Step Code, and
- Deletion of obsolete or redundant requirements and alignment with legislative changes.

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# DOWNTOWN TREE PRUNING SCHEDULED

As part of the annual street tree maintenance program, the City will be pollarding the London planes trees along Shoppers Row and Pier Street. Pollarding is a method of pruning used by the City. Pruning will occur on **February 26 and 27** and on **March 5 and 6, 2023**; the City selected Sunday and Monday to minimize disruption to local businesses.



During the tree work, the public can expect minor traffic delays, and portions of the sidewalk will be closed. Select parking stalls will also be temporarily allocated for equipment
