

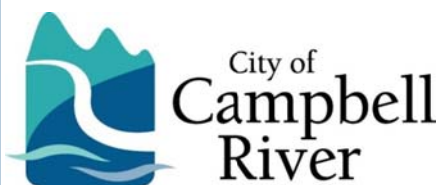
ENVIRONMENTAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE
