Comments from April 12th Public Visioning Workshop:

1. Co-operation with Band to put boardwalk with interpretive information through wetland to Tyee Spit and Thompson Trail
2. Buy this.
3. Dock for canoes/kayaks at Beehive, Robert Ostler Park.
4. Family picnic area, Heritage Park.
5. Waterfront should be considered 'Greenways'
6. Build this trail.
7. Trail system (adjacent to hwy.) bikes, horses, greenways
8. These trails do not exist or are not sanctioned.
9. There is no trail west of ERT.
10. Plant replacement for older Eagle perch and nest trees.
11. There is no crossing of Simms Creek here.
12. There is no sanctioned crossing of Simms Creek at corner of ERT and Airport Main.
13. Buy this piece of property, very wet, zoned for 20 lots. Will be a wonderful Gateway, and then a storm water drainage (area) for newer development.
