Officers and Municipal Employees Bylaw No. 3806, 2021

ADOPTED June 28, 2021

PURPOSE

To provide for the designation and establishment of powers, duties and responsibilities of Officers of the City of Campbell River as per the *Community Charter*, and to designate Municipal Employees for the purpose of the Financial Disclosure Act for the City of Campbell River.

This bylaw replaces Officers and Employees Bylaw No. 3224, 2006 as amended.

The Council of the City of Campbell River enacts as follows:

PART 1: Title

1.1 This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as Officers and Municipal Employees Bylaw No. 3806, 2021.

PART 2: Definitions

2.1 In this bylaw unless the context otherwise requires:

City means the municipality of the City of Campbell River

Council means the elected Council of the City

Enactment means an enactment of British Columbia and regulations

thereto, as amended, revised, consolidated or replace from time

to time

Employee means an exempt or union employee of the City

Officer means a person holding a position set out in Schedule A

PART 3: Establishment of Officers and Municipal Employees

- **3.1** The appointment of a person to any officer position identified in Schedule "A" inclusive must be by a resolution of Council.
- **3.2** All persons employed in the positions identified in Schedule "A" inclusive are designated to be "municipal employees" for the purpose of the Financial Disclosure Act.

PART 4: Powers, Duties and Responsibilities

- **4.1** In addition to any other powers, duties and functions assigned by Council, or required or permitted by the *Community Charter* or any other enactment, the Chief Administrative Officer and the Deputy Chief Administrative Officer shall be responsible for the Chief administrative functions of the City of Campbell River as outlined in Section 147 of the *Community Charter*.
- **4.2** In addition to any other powers, duties and functions assigned by Council, or required or permitted by the *Community Charter* or any other enactment, the Corporate Officer shall be responsible for the corporate administration functions of the City of Campbell River as outlined in Section 148 of the *Community Charter*.
- **4.3** In addition to any other powers, duties and functions assigned by Council, or required or permitted by the *Community Charter* or any other enactment, the Financial Officer shall be responsible for the financial administration functions of the City of Campbell River as outline in Section 149 of the *Community Charter*.

PART 5: Severability

5.1 If any section, subsection, paragraph, clause, phrase or word within this bylaw is for any reason held to be invalid by the decision of a court or competent jurisdiction, such decision does not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this bylaw.

PART 6: Repeal

6.1 Officers and Employees Bylaw No. 3224, 2006 as amended, is repealed.
