
- PROCLAMATION -

- AND WHEREAS** safety, quality and abundance of water can only be safeguarded by sound environmental protection, appropriate treatment, and properly maintained distribution systems,
- AND WHEREAS** we are all stewards of the water infrastructure which future generations depend upon,
- AND WHEREAS** each citizen of our community is called upon to help protect our source waters from pollution, to practice water conservation, and to get involved in local water issues,
- AND WHEREAS** federal, provincial, and local governments as well as concerned organizations, are cognizant and supportive of measures which promote safe, clean, and abundant water, and responsible wastewater management,
- AND WHEREAS** one such measure involves heightening public awareness of the value of our drinking water resources, and encouraging the public to promote this awareness.
