CALL FOR ARTISTS - YOUTH ARTIST COMPETITION

Submission deadline:
4:30pm September 30, 2011

The City of Campbell River, Wei Wai Kum, We Wai Kai and Homalco Nations invite youth artists from each community to submit works on the theme PARTNERSHIP for consideration for inclusion and display in the jointly developed document entitled "Governance and Planning Partnership Strategy". Using the theme of PARTNERSHIP, the City of Campbell River together with the Wei Wai Kum, We Wai Kai and Homalco Nations are developing a "Partnership and Governance Strategy" which outlines a new approach for working together. The process has increased understanding of the rich cultural diversity in our community and the uniqueness. It has reinforced the need for the City and local First Nations to work together in partnership for the long term health and sustainability of the region.

Preference will be given to works that respond in some way to the theme of PARTNERSHIP. Individual interpretations or variations on the theme are encouraged. Youth Artists are asked to submit 2-dimensional (e.g. drawing, painting, collage, photography, etc.) or digital works.

Eligibility

This call is open to all youth artists 19 years of age and younger from the Wei Wai Kum, We Wai Kai and Homalco Nations and broader City of Campbell River

communities.

Budget

A \$150 honorarium will be awarded to each of the winning submissions. No fees or costs directly or indirectly associated with the development or production of artwork will be eligible for reimbursement.

Selection Process

A Selection Panel will be established with knowledge and expertise in contemporary art practices and the local area. The role of the selection panel is to review and recommend one selected submission from each of the following communities:

- City of Campbell River
- Wei Wai Kum Nation
- We Wai Kai Nation
- Homalco Nation

Selection Criteria

Finalists will be selected on the following criteria:

- Artistic excellence, skill and innovation
- Appropriateness and relevance to the PARTNERSHIP theme
- Material and scale suitable to digital replication

Submissions

Submissions shall not exceed 24" x 36" and should include a brief description of how the work relates to the theme 'PARTNERSHIP' - each submission must include the name of the artist, medium used, address, email and telephone number. Submissions should be delivered to the contact person at the address associated with each community category as listed below.
