Licence fees within the City of Campbell River boundaries are:

Male or Female \$40
Spayed or Neutered..... \$20
Lost Tag Replacement..... \$10

Strathcona Area D (if paid before Feb 29, 2016)

Male or Female \$40/ \$45 after
Spayed or Neutered..... \$10/ \$15 after
Lost Tag Replacement..... \$10

The Campbell River Visitor Centre will be **temporarily closed** from January 22 to February 17 for renovations.

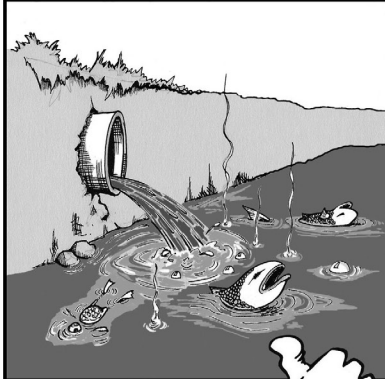
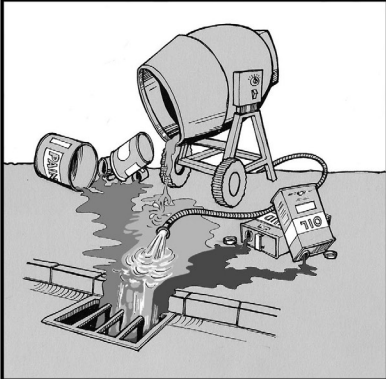
