## YARD WASTE COLLECTION STARTS MARCH 7

Curbside yard waste collection starts March 7  
and runs to November 25, 2016.



Yard waste will be collected weekly on the same day as residential garbage and recycling. Unlimited amounts of yard waste are accepted. Yard waste must be placed in containers no larger than 80L each (max. weight 20kg/44lbs), clearly marked Yard Waste, or in bags labeled as biodegradable or compostable by the manufacturer.

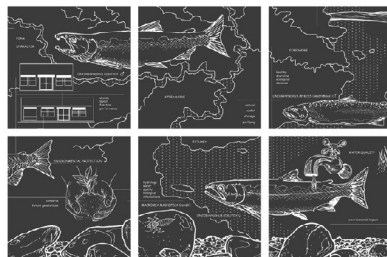
