NOTICE OF DISPOSITION OF PROPERTY

Pursuant to Sections 24 and 26 of the Community Charter

TAKE NOTICE that the City of Campbell River (the "City") has disposed of the land legally described as follows:

1. McIvor Lake

Lot 1, District Lot 87, Sayward District, Plan 27013, PID: 002-526-565

5-year Licence of Occupation Agreement from June 1, 2016 and terminating on May 31, 2021, to the Campbell River Eagles Water Ski Club, for a fee of \$1.00.

The City has also leased the following land at the Campbell River Airport:

 25-year lease from April 1, 2016 through March 31, 2041 with an option to renew for one (1) further term of twenty-five (25) years (Lease Area 4, Plan EPP35390) to DEFAB Enterprises, for an initial annual rent of \$1,775.95 plus GST.

Please note that the City will remain the registered, fee-simple owner of all lands described above.
