- Pole type: wooden (BC Hydro) or metal (City)
- Problem: Out? Flickering? Going on and off?
- Please also provide contact information (name and phone number).

In bad weather and dark conditions, pedestrians should take extra care to make sure they're visible.

- Wear reflective clothing and personal reflectors
- Walk against traffic
- Stick to sidewalks
- Walk in well-lit areas or light your way with a flashlight
