## NOTICE RE: AIRPORT LEASES

The City of Campbell River intends to lease the following lands at the Campbell River Airport.

- 1. 25-year lease from December 1, 2016 through November 30, 2041 (Lease Area 31, Plan EPP35390) to Mountain Storage Hangers Ltd., for an initial annual rent of \$2,955.00 plus GST.
- 2. 10-year lease from January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2026 (Lease Area 11, Plan EPP35390) to Kev Holdings Ltd., for an initial annual rent of \$8,924.10 plus GST.
- 20-year lease from November 15, 2016 through November 14, 2036 (Lease Area 23B, Plan EPP56151) to Jasbir Singh Bains and Rosanne Mary Bains, for an initial annual rent of \$4,137.00 plus GST.
- 20-year lease from November 15, 2016 through November 14, 2036 (Lease Area 39, Plan EPP35390) to Jasbir Singh Bains and Rosanne Mary Bains, for an initial annual rent of \$1,221.20 plus GST.

The City will remain the registered, fee-simple owner of all lands described above contained within Lot A, Sections 7, 8 and 18, Township 1 and Sections 13 and 24, Township 2, Comox District, Plan VIP74726, commonly known as the Campbell River Airport (YBL).
