## IT'S BACK TO SCHOOL

Safety tips for drivers travelling in a school zone:

- Every school day, unless otherwise posted, a 30 km/h speed limit is in effect in school zones from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- A vehicle stopped in front of you or in the lane next to you may be yielding to a pedestrian, so proceed with caution and be prepared to stop.
- Before getting into your vehicle, walk around it to make sure no small children are hidden from view. Always look for pedestrians when you're backing up.

### PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE OPPORTUNITY FOR INPUT Zoning Bylaw Amendment

A Public Hearing will be held in the Council Chambers of City Hall located at 301 St. Ann's Road in Campbell River, B.C. at 6:30 p.m. on September 11, 2017 to provide an opportunity for public input on Bylaw No. 3673, 2017.

**What is the purpose of Zoning Amendment Bylaw No. 3673, 2017?**  
Campbell River Head Injury Society is proposing to redevelop 531 9th Avenue for the purposes of a 27 unit apartment building to be designated as affordable housing. The applicant is seeking to rezone from Residential Multiple Three (RM-3) to Residential Multiple Four (RM-4) to allow for a higher density.
