Fire in building next to airport, smoke damage to interior and vehicles in storage

No one was injured, but the inside of a building and vehicles in storage there were damaged by smoke during a fire the evening of April 1.

“At 7:55 p.m. Campbell River fire crews responded to a call at a building located beside the Campbell River Airport, and found black smoke issuing from all four sides of a single-storey industrial building,” says deputy fire chief Chris Vrabel. “Once we gained access to the building we found a vehicle on fire inside the building. The on-duty airport employees working that evening were of great assistance to the response as they reported the fire and opened the gates to the area prior to our arrival.”

The cause of the fire has not been determined at this time.
