Campbell River’s first Garden Expo and Seedy Sunday will be held on Sunday, March 19 at the Community Centre.

The expo will host a seed swap, plant sale, demonstrations, a Li'l Sprouts Kids' corner, a concession and vendors from all over Vancouver Island.
