City publishes 2016 Annual Report, Council to review at June 19 meeting

The City of Campbell River has published its 2016 Annual Report, which will be reviewed at the June 19 Council meeting.

"The Annual Report identifies that 2016's hard work and achievements have laid a strong foundation of plans and new initiatives for another progressive year in 2017," says City manager Deborah Sargent. "This report again features spectacular Campbell River photos, a By the Numbers section highlighting key community service statistics, graphic icons throughout the departmental reviews that provide snapshot information at a glance and an ever-growing Awards and Milestones section."

The City is required by law to produce an annual report that includes the City's audited financial statements before June 30 each year. The document also provides a comprehensive summary of the City's strategic goals and objectives as well as services provided to the community. It highlights 2016 achievements and awards and lays out goals for 2017-2018. The document also contains historical and demographic information.

The City of Campbell River's 2016 Annual Report is posted under *What's New* on the City's website (www.campbellriver.ca) and will be archived with previous annual reports under *Your City Hall / Financial Plans Reports*. People can also request a paper copy from City Hall reception.
