The City commemorates Al Hodgkinson with a plaque

The City will install a commemorative plaque at the entrance to the Discovery Fishing Pier to memorialize Mr. Al Hodgkinson's significant role in planning and designing the first salt water fishing pier in Canada.

Mr. Hodgkinson, who worked for the City as a Building Inspector, spent a considerable amount of time, above and beyond his regular work hours, to ensure the successful completion of this project.

The Community Services, Recreation and Culture Commission recently approved the design of the plaque which will be placed at the entrance to Discovery Pier in the memory of Al Hodgkinson. The plaque is solid cast bronze is set to be installed Thursday July 31, 2014.

This landmark fishing pier was built in 1987, extends 150 feet from shore, and is 600 feet long.
