

# NORM WOOD ENVIRONMENTAL CENTRE (NVEC) UPGRADE PHASE 1

SPRING 2013 to SPRING 2014

*On Time and Under Budget!*

## Project Overview

Work under this project included upgrading the City's existing sewage treatment facility, Norm Wood Environmental Centre, to increase capacity, provide required system redundancy, and to address existing operational concerns. The first phase of this project included the construction of a third secondary clarifier, a second RAS pump station as well as electrical upgrades.

Opus DaytonKnight Consultants Ltd. were awarded RFP No. 678 to complete detailed design. Construction work was publicly tendered in March 2013, and the lowest price tenderer, Kinetic Construction Ltd., was awarded the contract. Construction was complete in August 2014.



## Funding for the Project

The project was funded through a combination of Sewer Accumulated Surplus and Development Cost Charges. The final total cost of design and construction works associated with the Norm Wood Environmental Centre Upgrade - Phase 1 was \$5,084,787 million against the approved \$5,519 million budget.
