We're Getting Ready—Here's What You Need to Know

Water service renewals on Highway 28 will be starting soon in your area.



The Highway 28 Water Service Renewal Project is about to begin. This project involves the renewal of seven (7) residential services, installation of one (1) fire hydrant and one (1) isolation valve on Highway 28 between Quinsam and Doyle Roads.

Getting Ready for Construction

Work is anticipated to commence September 8, 2015 and be completed by end of September. The work is limited to the road right of way. Local residents may experience minor inconveniences. The contractor will be responsible for ensuring access is maintained to your property at all times.

Road Closures

This project will require single lane closure on Highway 28 around the active work area with alternating traffic passing the work zone. The contractor will be required to maintain appropriate traffic control throughout the course of construction. Signs will be posted to provide clear direction for drivers and pedestrians on travelling around the active work zone.

Construction Impacts

As work takes place in front of your home, on street parking may not be available. As the contractor gets close to service switchovers, affected residents living at all addresses along this route will be contacted in advance so as to ensure any disruption is minimized as your service is renewed from the old watermain to new.
