Q & A: Robron Park Field House Civil Works

In Fall 2017 construction of the civil works (site servicing) will be underway. The following questions and answers are intended to provide an overview of the project.


1. What is the project?

Work under this project consists of the installation of approximately 330 lineal metres of sanitary sewer piping including manholes and connections to the existing system in preparation for the construction of the future fieldhouse.

2. Where is the project?

The project is located at Robron Park as shown here on this map.

3. When is the construction work going to take place? Construction is expected to commence in Fall 2017 and be completed by the end of this year.



4. What is the cost of the project?

The project is currently being tendered after which time the project cost will be known.

5. Who has been involved in developing the plans?

The Robron Park Master Plan completed in 2009, included the concept of a central fieldhouse at the site. City Council has approved the installation of site serves for this future project.

6. Who will be constructing the work?

Tender No. 17-59 for construction is currently posted on the city's bid opportunity webpage. The tender closes on October 2, 2017. A recommendation of award will follow and require approval by City Council.

7. How will traffic be managed during construction?

Traffic management during construction will be the responsibility of the contractor doing the work. A traffic management plan will be required for all necessary works on Robron Road which will include single lane alternating traffic while servicing is connected to the new system.
