

## Q & A: Municipal Broadband Network 11th Avenue Extension Project

The City is getting ready to commence with the installation of CR Advantage, a municipal broadband fibre network project.

The following questions and answers are intended to provide an overview of the project.



### 1. What is the project?

Work under this project includes the extension of the city's municipal broadband network from the Community Centre to Dogwood Street. This will allow for the expansion of the service area and allow customers to connect to the City's network. ### 2. Where is the project?

The project area for this work is along 11th Avenue from Cedar Street to Dogwood Street, and Dogwood Street from 11th to 12th Avenue.

### 3. When is the construction work going to take place?

Construction is expected to commence in late spring and be complete by early summer 2020.

### 4. What is the cost of the project?

The scope of the project is being finalized and costs will be confirmed as soon as the contract for construction is being negotiated with the city's fibre network support contractor, Lite Access Technologies.

### 5. How is the project being funded?

The project is approved in the 2020 Capital Plan and is funded by the Gaming Reserve.

### 6. Who will be involved in the project design and construction?

The civil design work was completed by the City's Capital Works Department and an agreement for construction is in place with Lite Access Technologies who will be completing the installation.

### 7. How will traffic be managed during construction?

Traffic management during construction is the responsibility of the contractor doing the work. Lite Access Technologies plan involves single lane closures and on street parking restrictions as alternating traffic passes the work zone.

The contractor is required to maintain appropriate traffic control throughout the course of construction. Any further updates will be communicated once construction commences.
