

Q & A: NVEC Biosolid Site Management Project

Work is about to begin at the Norm Wood Environmental Centre. The following questions and answers are intended to provide an overview of the project.

1. What is the project?

Work under this project includes reclaiming the biosolid application area at the Norm Wood Environmental Centre.

Phase I consists of rehabilitating Field 1 starting with the clearing of a treed area under RFP 19-20, followed by an earth works project to strip and reshape some areas of the field to allow for the bio solids apparatus to operate on both fields #1 and #2 without any obstructions. Phase II will consist of the rehabilitation of Field #2 in the following application season.



2. Where is the project?

All of the work is confined to the Norm Wood Environmental Centre which is located in the northern section of the City.

3. Who has been involved in developing the plans?

The Capital Works and Sanitary Sewer Departments engaged Sylvis Environmental to provide an assessment of soil removal. This assessment provided the feasibility report to support site rejuvenation.



4. When is the construction work going to take place?

Phase I will begin this Spring and is expected to be complete this Summer. Phase II will begin in Spring 2020.

5. What is the cost of the project?

2019 Budget Deliberations approved \$500,000 in 2019 for Biosolids Management and is being funded through the Sewer Reserve. Field 2 costs are yet to be determined.

6. Who will be constructing the work?

Integrated Operations Group will be completing the tree clearing under RFP 19-20. This will be followed by a construction tender being posted for the public in Spring 2019 for the remaining Phase I (earth works). Phase II will be a construction tender.



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
