

## Q & A: 2019 Sewermain Rehabilitation Projects

The following Questions and Answers are intended to provide an overview of this project.

**1. What is the project?**

Work under this contract consists of the rehabilitation of approximately 1000 lineal meters of existing sanitary sewer mains through the use of Trenchless Technology called Cured In Place Pipe (CIPP) lining method. The work is to be delivered in 12 distinct segments as defined by manhole to manhole sections of relevant sewer main pipe and service connections.

**2. Where are the project locations?**

- 968 to 998 Shoppers Row
- 12th Ave at Dogwood St
- 16th Ave at Cedar St
- 1116 and 1140 Dogwood St
- 16th Ave at Dogwood St
- Dogwood & 16th Ave
- 16th Ave at the Old Spit Rd
- 690 Island Hwy
- 1409, 1416 and 1441 16th Ave

**3. When is the construction work going to take place?**

Construction is expected to commence in late Summer 2019 and be completed by end of November 2019.

**4. What is the cost of the project?**

The final cost of the project will be known once the RFP has been awarded.

**5. How is the project being funded?**

Budget has been approved in the 2019 Capital Plan and is funded by the sewer reserve.

**6. Who will be involved in the project design and construction?**

The work is being completed under a design-bid-built model. Design has been completed by the City's Capital Works and Sewer Departments. An RFP for sourcing a specialized contractor has been publically posted and closes on May 21, 2019.

**7. How will traffic be managed during construction?**

Traffic management during construction will be the responsibility of the contractor doing the work. The contractor will have traffic control in place ensuring safe passage for vehicles and pedestrians around the work zone at all times.

**8. What do I need to know?**

Your sewer service connection to the sewer mainline will have to be **temporarily closed off** during repairs. We need your cooperation to avoid back up of the sewer water into your residence or business by preventing water from entering the sewer through any drains during the specified time period. As a result, it is imperative that you do not perform the following household activities.

**Please:** avoid washing clothes, dishes, do not take showers or baths, do not flush toilets or operate sump pumps connected to the sewer system. Please call 250-286-5756 if you have an concerns while the work is taking place.
