FIRESMART ACTIVITIES INCLUDE:

- Clearing all combustible debris from roof and gutters
- Pruning low tree branches to create a two-metre ground clearance
- Removing all combustible material from underneath decks
- Moving firewood and unused propane tanks at least 10 metres from structures
- Installing non-combustible 3 mm screens to external vents (except dryer vents)
- Cleaning-up brush piles, cones, fallen branches, or standing dead trees
- Taking down coniferous trees within 10 metres of your home

By taking action and creating a FireSmart property, you will dramatically increase its resistance to damage caused by wildfire. The best part is; it's surprisingly easy to do.

The actions recommended in the FireSmart BC Homeowner's Manual start from the home and progress outwards. Changes to areas closest to your home have the greatest potential to reduce the risk of wildfire damage.

TO QUALIFY:

STEP 1

Book a **FREE** FireSmart Home Assessment with our FireSmart Coordinator.

STEP 2

Carry out one or more of the recommendations from the assessment. Log all the hours and save receipts if help is hired.

STEP 3

Book a post-work assessment with our FireSmart Coordinator and submit the completed **'Recommended Activities Form'** and receipts to get your rebate.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Rebates are limited to 50% of the total cost of eligible activities and no more than \$1000 per property.
- The number of rebates available are limited and will be issued on a first come, first served basis.
- Rebates are available to City of Campbell River home owners.
- Work or expenses completed prior to the FireSmart Home Assessment are not eligible.
