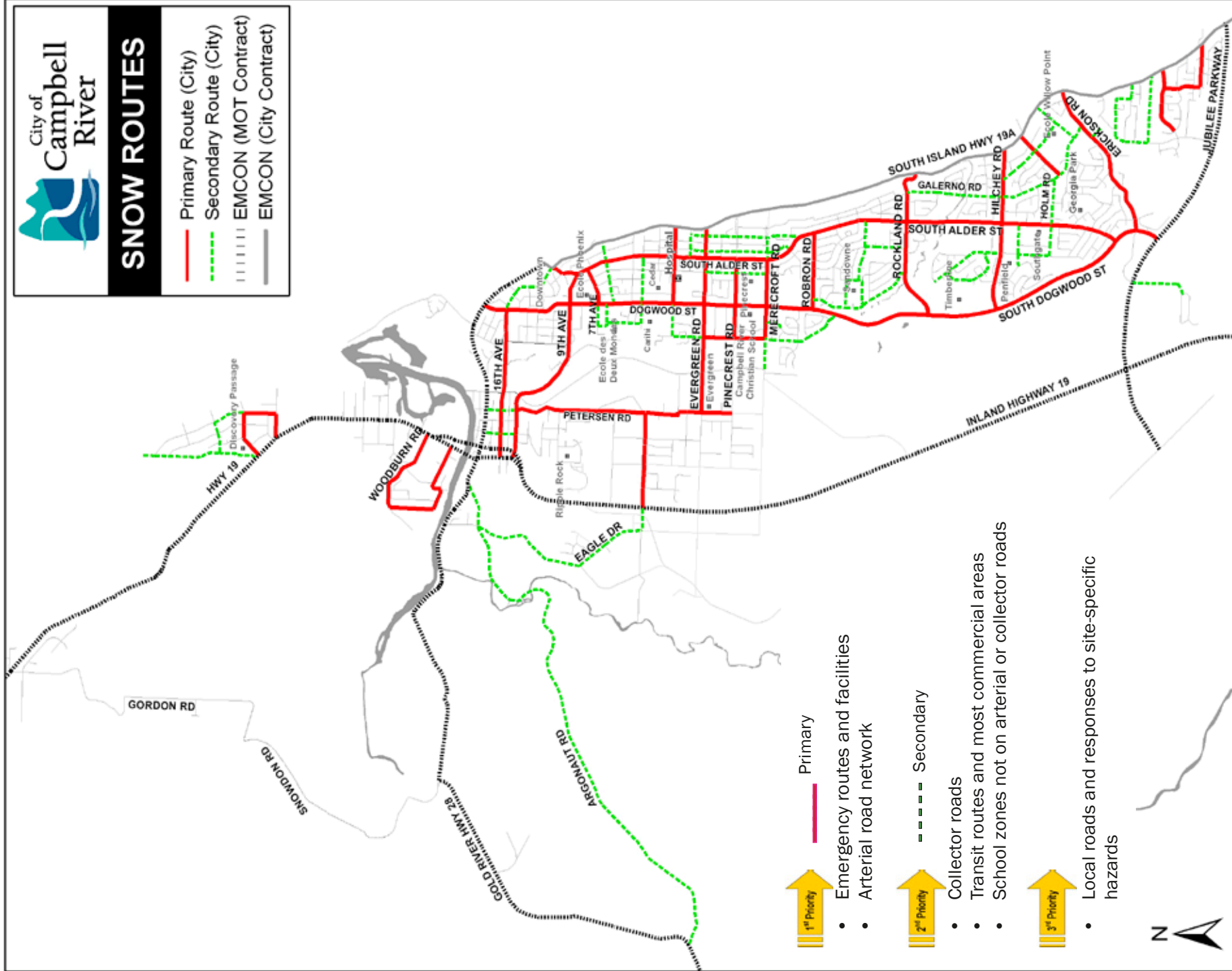

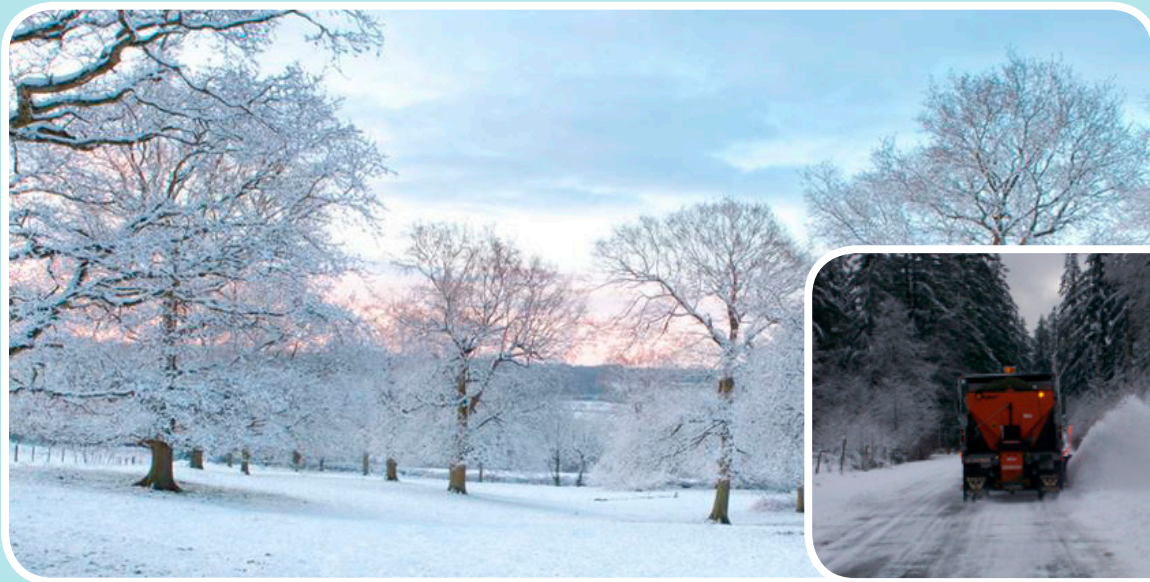

Residents are requested to clear snow and ice from sidewalks in front of their dwellings.

The City of Campbell River's *Snow and Ice Management Policy* ensures that:

- emergency response routes are maintained;
- transit services can continue;
- road hazards are reduced; and
- the public has reasonable access to arterial and collector roadways in our community.

This policy covers the winter months from **November 1 to March 1** and applies to the City's roads and maintained trail networks, as well as sidewalks and parking lots at City facilities. The provincial government manages snow and ice along provincial highways.

Commercial, institutional and industrial occupants are responsible for clearing sidewalks around their properties.

The City's snow removal goal is to keep open a minimum of one driving lane (two lanes on arterial and collector roads) to provide emergency vehicles and the public with reasonable access and passable driving lanes around the community. In extreme storm events, this might not mean bare pavement on all routes. This allows us to clear more road surfaces for greater public access.

How the City will respond to snow storms

Minor Storm Events

- 1st: Sanding / salting streets & intersections
- 2nd: Plowing streets

Major Storm Events

- 1st: Plowing streets
- 2nd: Sanding / salting streets & intersections

Shoveling snow can be hard work, and the plow driver makes every effort to steer clear of depositing snow in freshly shoveled areas.

Please help us by NOT shoveling or blowing snow into the street.
