

## PROPERTY AGREEMENTS NOTICE

The City of Campbell River has undertaken the following legal agreements:

- Robron Park (425 Merecroft Road)  
15-year Licence of Occupation Agreement for the use of office and storage space in the Rotary Community Fieldhouse upon its completion, to the Campbell River Youth Soccer Association, for a fee of \$1.00.  
*Legal Description: Lot B, Section 32, Township 1, Comox District, Plan 33326

- Parking Lot at Maritime Heritage Centre (621 Island Highway)  
5-year Licence of Use Agreement from April 1, 2020 and terminating on October 31, 2025, to the Pier Street Association for the Pier Street Farmers Market, for an annual fee of \$1,000 in addition to permit fees.

- 5-year lease from January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2024 to Campbell River Air Youth Association, for an initial annual rent of \$3,000.80 plus GST.

## CURBSIDE YARD WASTE COLLECTION STARTS MONDAY, MARCH 2

Important how-to tips:

- Unlimited amounts of yard waste are accepted.
- Place yard waste in a rigid, lidded container no larger than 80 litres each (maximum weight 20kg/44lbs).
- Container must be clearly marked Yard Waste.
- Tie branches and prunings in secure bundles measuring maximum 90 centimetres (36 inches) long and 60 centimetres (24 inches) wide. Diameter of individual branches must not exceed 7.5 centimetres (3 inches).
- ***Please note: Paper bags accepted, but no yard waste in plastic bags – even if labelled biodegradable.***

Campbell River residents can also take material to the Yard Waste Drop-off Centre. Open year-round Friday to Tuesday 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (Closed Wednesday and Thursday)

Location: west of the Inland Highway off Willis Road, past the Shell Station.  
No charge for City of Campbell River residents. (There is a fee for commercial use.)
