- WHEREAS** prostate cancer is the most common cancer risk to affect Canadian men;
- AND WHEREAS** one in seven Canadian men will be diagnosed with the disease;
- AND WHEREAS** an estimated 11 Canadian men will die from prostate cancer every day;
- AND WHEREAS** the survival rate for prostate cancer can be close to 100% when detected early, but three of four men will die when it's found late;
- AND WHEREAS** black men and those with a family history of the disease are at a greater risk;
- AND WHEREAS** since Prostate Cancer Canada was formed in 1994, the death rate has been cut in half;
- AND WHEREAS** awareness and conversations about prostate cancer can lead to screening and early detection that saves lives;
- AND WHEREAS** the City of Campbell River supports Prostate Cancer Canada and all individuals committed to raising awareness about prostate cancer;
