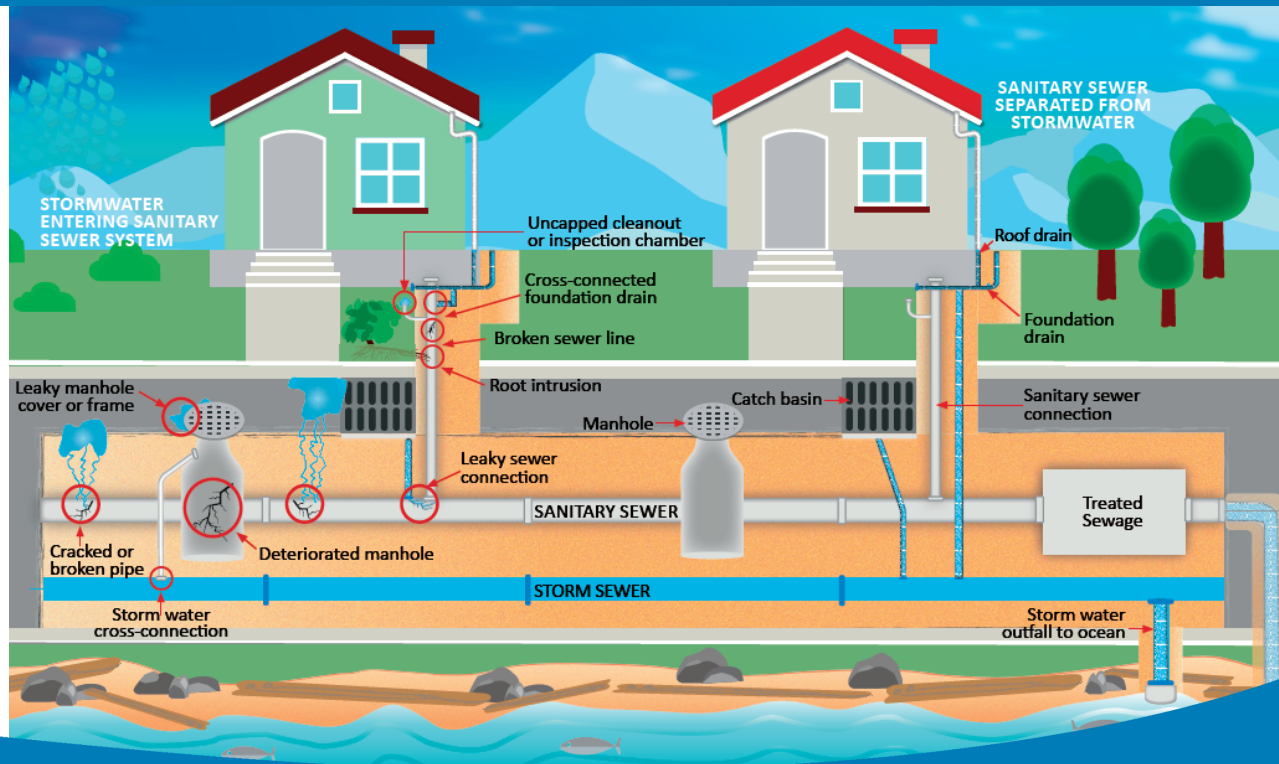


TIPS FOR PREVENTING STORM WATER FROM ENTERING THE SEWER SYSTEM

- Inspect roof gutters, downspouts, and groundwater sump pumps to make sure they are NOT connected to the sanitary sewer system. If they are, have them disconnected and direct downspouts into the storm system, rain barrels, onto lawns or garden beds.
- Never drain standing water from your property into a manhole, cleanout, or inspection chamber.
- Avoid planting any trees or shrubs over sanitary sewer or storm drain systems.
- Have building sewer connections inspected by a plumber to identify leaking pipes – with the added benefit of catching potential system blocks before they cause sanitary sewer backups.
- For the upcoming storm season, help prevent localized flooding in your neighbourhood by cleaning leaves from catch basin grates close to your home. If there's a culvert near your property, please monitor to make sure it's clear of debris.



HELP EASE DRAIN PAIN

Make sure rain water from your property is going into storm drains and not the sanitary sewer system. Call the City's **Dogwood Operations Centre** with questions or to report problems **250-286-4033**.
