

ORGANICS CURBSIDE COLLECTION LIMITED TO 360 LITRES PER WEEK

3 STEPS TO COMPOST FOOD WASTE





Empty the kitchen bin and yard waste into a strong-lidded container made of plastic, rubber, or galvanized steel.



Place the strong-lidded food and yard waste container at the curb on the day of collection. No bag or container should weigh more than 20kg and all organic waste should not exceed a volume of 360 litres.



HELP PREVENT CONTAMINATION

- NO plastic bags, plates or cutlery even those labelled compostable or biodegradable.
- NO plastic or foam containers including takeout food containers.

Mondays, Wednesdays and Saturdays (for even-numbered addresses)

5 to 9 a.m. and 7 to 10 p.m.



Watering gardens, plant beds and lawns by hand, or using a hose with an automatic shut-off nozzle, is permitted at any time.

The City has received an application for a Zoning Bylaw Amendment at 2105 Shetland Road (LOT 3, DISTRICT LOT 1385, SAYWARD DISTRICT, PLAN 11342)

The proposed amendment will rezone the property from Residential One (RE-1) to Residential Multiple Two (RM-2) to allow duplexes with secondary suites in conjunction with a 17-lot subdivision.
