Let's meet - City launching new process for development applications, starting July 29

To help streamline the approval process, all developers will now meet with city planners when submitting development applications.

"Campbell River continues to be a very busy place for development, and development can be complicated," says Peter Wipper, director of planning. "We recognize that applicants need to be able to plan their projects, and we are striving to ensure everyone understands the process and knows what's next to help everything run as smoothly as possible."

A meeting between a city planner and applicant will help streamline the review and approvals process because the planner will make sure the application is complete, and clarify what's required if anything is missing. The meeting will also lay out timelines for the application, so everyone knows what to expect and when.

"This is an example of how we intend to make our processes clearer for all development applicants," says Kevin Brooks, development services manager. "The City is committed to ongoing improvements to enhance the application process."
