New street, new traffic signal: Lights at Willow Creek Road intersection now in operation

Willow Creek Road has opened to provide another way for people to get to and from the Maryland neighbourhood.

The new route, between Jubilee Parkway and Arizona Drive, has a new traffic signal at Willow Creek and Jubilee Parkway and a four-way stop at Willow Creek and Arizona Drive.

"A traffic light at this new intersection provides Maryland area residents with safer access," says Drew Hadfield, the City's director of operations. "Signs are up to remind drivers that the speed limit on Willow Creek Road is 50km/hr, and we would like to thank drivers for driving cautiously while we all adjust to this new street."

The new route, the traffic signal, and intersection improvements at Willow Creek Road and Jubilee Parkway were required by the Province and the City and fully paid for by the developer, Parkway Properties and Maryland Estates, as a condition of development.

The traffic signal at Highway 19A and Maryland Road is currently under construction and is anticipated to be completed in October. This work is funded by City. Cost is \$137,550.
