Quick response and fire sprinklers minimize damage at Campbell River Golf & Country Club

The Campbell River Fire Department responded to fire alarms ringing at the Campbell River Golf & Country Club at 11:45 p.m. Thursday.

"The fire crew encountered smoke in the lobby and quickly worked to extinguish the fire in the kitchen area," says fire chief lan Baikie. "Thankfully, the fire hadn't had a chance to take off because two of the building's automatic sprinklers were actively applying water in this part of the building."

Fire damage was confined to a portion of the kitchen and the wall separating the kitchen and the adjoining dining room.

"The building owner intends to re-open the restaurant in the near future," Baikie adds.
