Instructions:

- 1. Complete this 'Application to Vote by Mail' form and either mail, fax (250-286-5760), email (front.reception@campbellriver.ca) or deliver it to Campbell River City Hall, 301 St. Ann's Road, Campbell River, BC, V9W 4C7 by **October 24, 2014.**
- 2. If your application is filled out correctly, the City of Campbell River will send you a mail ballot package following the official Declaration of the Election.
- 3. The completed mail ballot package MUST be received at Campbell River City Hall no later than 4:30 pm on Friday, November 14, 2014 or have it delivered to the Presiding Election Official at the Campbell River Community Center voting place located at 401 11th Avenue between 8:00 am and 8:00 pm Saturday, November 15, 2014.

- (1) You must meet all of the requirements in this section in order to register as a Non-Resident Property Elector.
- (2) Print applicant's surname and given names in full in block letters here.
- (3) Print the street address or legal description of the applicant's real property in relation to which the applicant is registering.
- (4) Print mailing address.
- (5) This information is required pursuant to the *Local Government Act*.
- (6) This information is to identify persons who have had a name change since the last election and who were on the list of electors.
- (7) Applicant must sign here.
- (8) A person who was present when applicant signed his/her name on line (8) must sign here.
- (9) Witness' address here. Not required if the witness is an election official.
- (10) You must attach the "Non-Resident Property Elector Consent Form" if the land title registration of the real property in relation to which a person is registering under this section indicates that there is more than one individual who is the registered owner of the real property. The person registering must do so with the written consent of the number of those individuals who, together with the person registering, are a majority of those individuals.
- (11) If person is registering at the time of voting, 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) to prove identity are required.
