strengthen partnerships with other levels of government, community organizations, as well as the public and private sectors, to honour and protect the rights of all Aboriginal

Peoples.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT I, Roy Grant, Acting Mayor of

the City of Campbell River, do hereby proclaim June 21st,

2011 to be:

"ABORIGINAL DAY"
