- PROCLAMATION-

- *WHEREAS* this year marks the 26th anniversary of the Campbell River Crime Stoppers program, one of the oldest and most successful programs in British Columbia;
- AND WHEREAS during the month of January 2017, Campbell River joins with communities around the Province of British Columbia to promote, share and celebrate the success of Crime Stoppers programs. The City of Campbell River supports the promotion of these community based Programs by proclaiming "Crime Stoppers Month";
- AND WHEREAS since its inception in 1992, Campbell River Crime Stoppers has received over 5,275 tips leading to the arrest of over 572 individuals and the resolution of over 1,396 cases. Tips to the program have also led to the recovery of over\$450,512 in stolen property and the seizure of over \$9,188,431 in illicit drugs;
- AND WHEREAS Crime Stoppers is a partnership between the police, the community and the media. Its incredible success can be attributed to the continued support from residents and organizations. Campbell River is a city committed to keeping its people safe. When concerned citizens watch out for each other and report crimes to the appropriate authorities we all benefit;
